1. Book Title and Author **10 points**
2. Your rating of the book (1-5 stars) with explanation (why did you give it this rating?) **30 points**
3. Summary of the book **30 points**
4. Quotes- select 3-5 important quotes from the text and explain them **30 points**

\*Optional- create a new cover for the book! This can be done in any way you like. BE CREATIVE **+5 points**
